Over the years, the Journal has extended its scope to encompass coverage of the latest clinical advances from the endovascular field. The Journal is indexed in BIOSIS, Current Contents, Excerpta Medica, Index Medicus (MEDLINE/PUBMED), MDS, Research Alert, Science Citation Index Expanded (SciSearch) and currently has an Impact Factor of 1.352.
